Maritime research at Southampton Solent University includes:

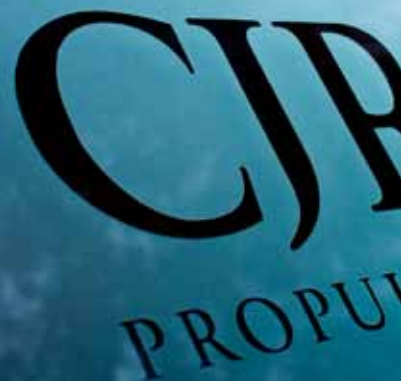


Maritime human factors and resource management, behavioural markers, maritime environmental management, and ship hydrodynamics.
